Plant these FREE wildflower seeds to help the bees!

Just scatter them over a square metre of your garden or pop them into pots.

Instructions and seeds inside.

Contains: Cornflower, Common Poppy, Corncockle, Corn Chamomile and Corn Marigold



Bees & other pollinating insects have declined significantly over the last 50-years. Together, we can give them a helping hand by sowing these seeds & avoiding the use of harmful pesticides.

Instructions - Plant before the end of May

- 1. Clear and lightly dig over a square meter of soil OR fill a few pots with soil or peat-free potting compost and place in an open position.
- 2. Scatter seeds & cover with a fine layer of soil.
- 3. Firm down gently and water.
- 4. Keep soil damp.
- 5. Thin out seedlings if necessary.
- 6. Share photos and register your B² plot on social media and the PRTC website.
- 7. Let us know what insects visit your flowers.
