8. CORRESPONDENCE

A request to use Wades Park has been received from the North West Chilterns Community Board (NWCCB)Buckinghamshire Council (BC)

The NWCCB has requested to use the park free of charge on the 24th June 2023 for their large annual event to promote the NWCCB and invite residents, various community/singing /dancing groups/ choirs, police, fire brigade, stall holders, live band, food, arts and crafts stalls and present their Pride of Bucks Awards. 10. TASK & FINISH GROUPS

Cllr Ball proposed the Wades Centre Office Space as the 3rd Task & Finish Group for this quarter Seconded by Cllr Turner.

Resolved: To establish a Task & Finish Group this quarter for the Wades Centre Office Space consisting of Cllrs Ball, Turner, J Coombs, S Coombs, Shipley, Rampin, Parkinson and the Clerk.

The Clerk advised that Officer Cate Holloway can only deal with the current Task & Finish Groups and not previous ones.

11. ELECTION COSTS

Cllr Ball proposed to approve the viring of funds from reserves to cover the Town Council by-election costs Seconded by Cllr Turner.

Resolved: To approve the viring of funds from reserves to cover the Town Council by-election costs.

12. PHASE 2 AND 3 OF THE REFURBISHMENT AND EXTENSION OF THE WADES CENTRE TO INCLUDE NEW AND ADDITIONAL TOILETS, OFFICE SPACE AND A RECEPTION DESK, A MAINTENANCE TEAM WELFARE SPACE, A CHANGING PLACES TOILET, AND A CONNECTING CORRIDOR BETWEEN THE MAIN ENTRANCE WITH THE CHANGING PLACES TOILET

The Clerk notified the members that the planning permission had been approved for the refurbishment and extension of the Wades Centre to include new and additional toilets, office space and a reception desk, a MT welfare space, a Changing places Toilet, and a connecting corridor between the main entrance and the Carrington Room and the Changing Places Toilet.

a) The Clerk & Responsible Financial Officer presented to the Council a Business Case for their approval which had been previously circulated to the members for their consideration. She informed members of the need to agree how much money will be required to borrow from the Public Works Loan Board. This will be in order to refurbish and extend the Wades Centre to include new and additional toilets, office space and a reception desk in Phase 2.

Cllr Ball proposed to amend the Business Case to include a 10% contingency and suggested that the loan should be £130,000 over 15 years.

Seconded by Cllr Turner.

Resolved: To approve the amended Business Case to include a 10% contingency for the refurbishment and extension of the Wades Centre to include new and additional toilets, office space and a reception desk, a MT welfare space, a Changing places Toilet, and a connecting corridor between the main entrance and the Carrington Room and the Changing Places Toilet.

b) Approval from the Secretary of State for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities, for the proposed borrowing for the expansion and refurbishment of the Wades Centre for the office space, reception desk and towards the cost of replacement and additional toilets

Cllr A Turner proposed that the Town Council seek approval from the Secretary of State for the proposed borrowing of

£130,000 over 15 years from the Public Works Loan Board (PWLB) for the expansion and refurbishment of the Wades Centre to provide office space, a reception desk and towards the cost of replacement and additional toilets within the centre. The annual loan repayments will be approximately £10,464 per year, based on the PWLB repayment costs dated 22/7/22. It will not be necessary to increase the council tax precept for the purpose of the loan repayments as the cost of the annual loan repayments are less than the annual amount currently budgeted for the Town Council office rent in the existing premises.

Seconded by Cllr Ball.

At the Princes Risborough Town Council meeting on the 26th July 2022, it was RESOLVED to seek the approval of the Secretary of State for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities to apply for a PWLB loan of £130,000 over the borrowing term of 15 years for the expansion and refurbishment of the Wades Centre to provide office space, a reception desk and towards the cost of replacement and additional toilets within the centre. The annual loan repayments will be approximately £10,464. It is not intended to increase the council tax precept for the purpose of the loan repayments.

c) Cllr Ball proposed to approve the plans for phase 2 of the extension and refurbishment of the Wades Centre to enable construction drawings to be completed for the Town Council to go out to tender for the project. Seconded by Cllr Shipley.

Resolved: To approve the plans for phase 2 of the extension and refurbishment of the Wades Centre to enable construction drawings to be completed for the Town Council to go out to tender for the project.

d) Cllr Ball proposed to proceed with obtaining quotations for the appointment of M&E and Structural engineers for phase 2 of the extension and refurbishment of the Wades Centre.

Cllr Ball proposed to approve the allocation of £12,000 CIL funds received to cover the cost of the construction drawings, ME and Structural engineers' costs for the provision of new and additional toilets in the Wades Centre as part of the phase 2 refurbishment of the Wades Centre.

Seconded by Cllr Hall.
